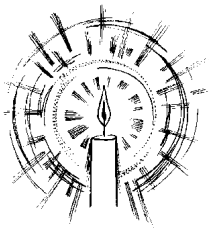

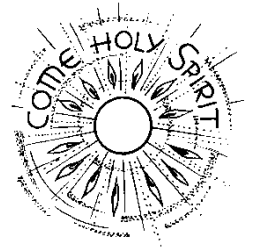

We wish sincere sympathies to all members of the Polish Community at their great loss.

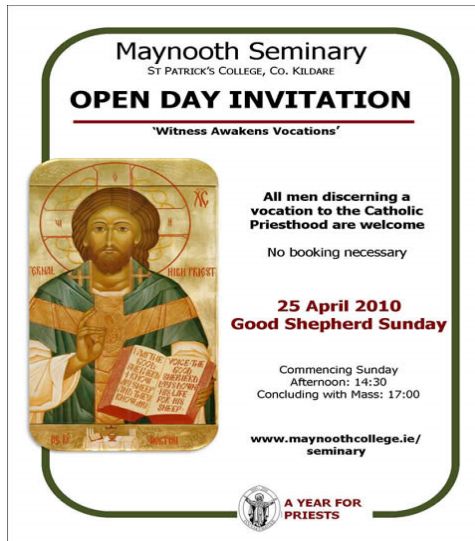

## Parish Pastoral Council

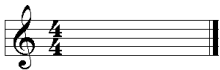
