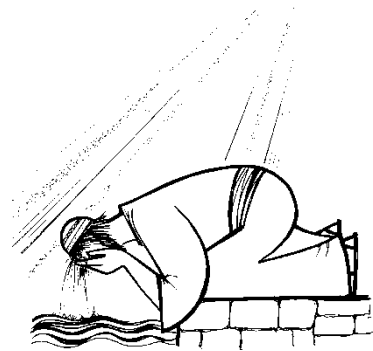

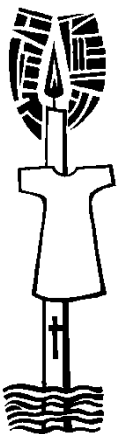
Welcome to the parish **Grace Mary Guilfoyle**, daughter of Claire and Connor who was baptised into the parish this week.

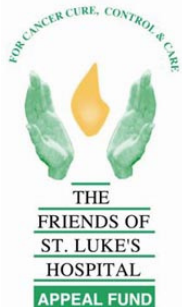

Poles take special pride in preparing a decorative and tasteful basket with crisp linens, occasionally embroidered for the occasion, and boxwood and ribbon woven through the handle. Observing the creativity of other parishioners is one of the special joys of the event. This ceremony will be observed in St. James' Church on Holy Saturday.
