Survivors in northwest Pakistan appeal for help

What some of the survivors of the floods have to say:

"Right now everything is out of our hands, there is not even rubbish to search through because all is washed away. We sit here and wonder if it will be the rain or the heat from the sun that will kill us off"

"We only want you to rescue our children"

"These roads and bridges are not our losses, these are the governments' and will be replaced. Our losses are our homes and our belongings, who will replace these?"

"Do not come to watch us die, please do something....."

There is a Special collection for Pakistan at all Masses this weekend. The usual Sunday collection varies from €1,000 – €1,300 each week. Anything over €1,000 will be immediately forwarded to Trocaire. Please help in whatever way you can.

About 60 Irish missionaries from the Missionary Congregations are ministering in Pakistan, including the Columban Fathers, Dalgan Park, Navan, the Holy Ghost Fathers and the Presentation Sisters. The Sisters have schools in the Swat valley which was the scene of severe fighting some months ago and has now been devastated by the floods.
