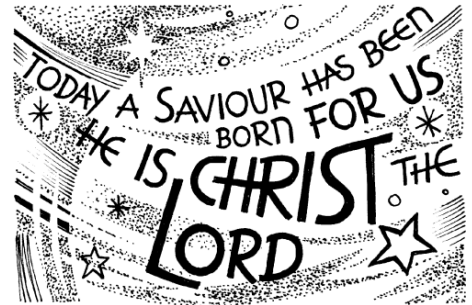

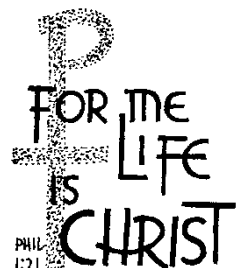

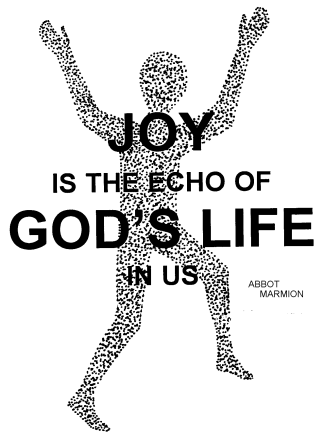


Eucharistic Adoration will be in Rahugh on Thursday 30th Dec. It will return to Fridays in January. New members are sought.

The members of the St. Vincent de Paul Society would like to thank all those who supported them leading up to Christmas. They received €2,371 in the Church gate collection last week.

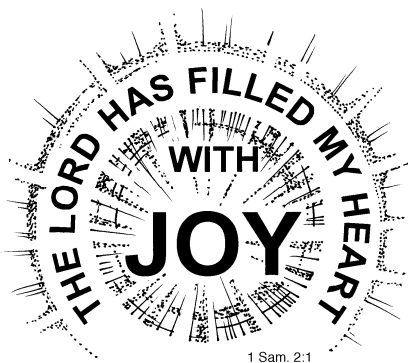
