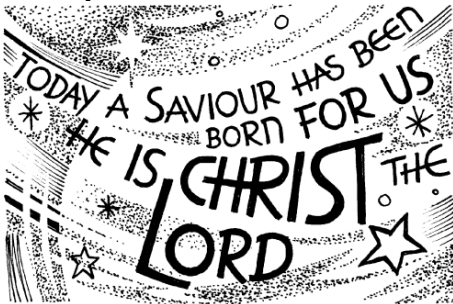

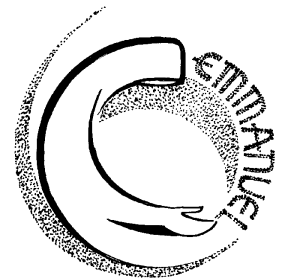
### **Sacrament of Reconciliation**

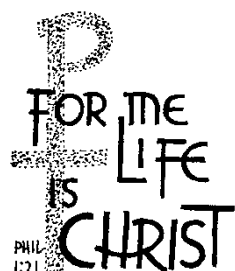


**Christmas Day is an Offering day** in the Parish, thanks to all who support the parish so generously.
