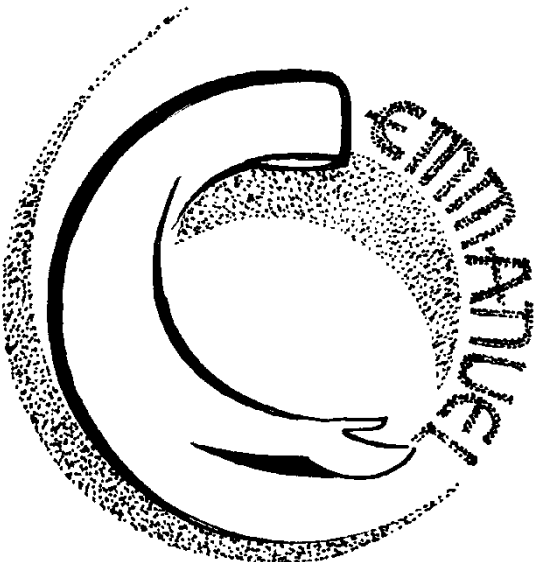

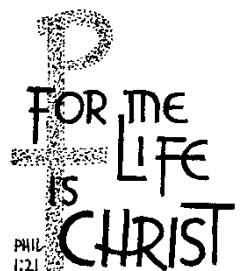

Please pray for the repose of the soul of **Crissie Dunican**, The Square, Kilbeggan, who died during the week. May Crissie rest in peace.

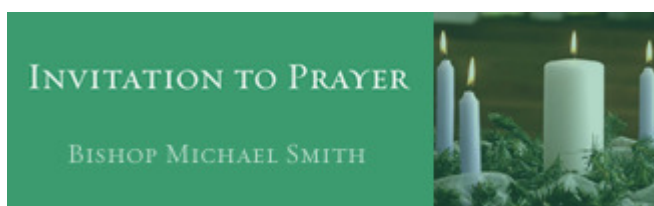
There is a meeting of the Parish Pastoral Council at 7.30 p.m. in The Staffroom of Scoil an Chlochair on Monday 13th.
