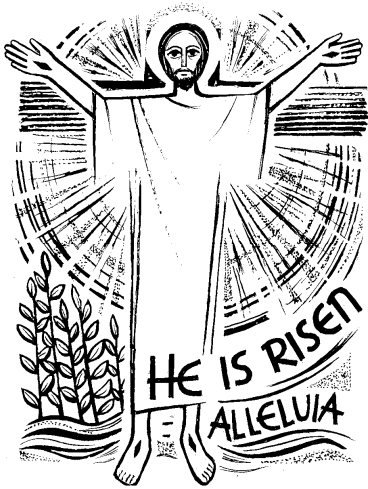

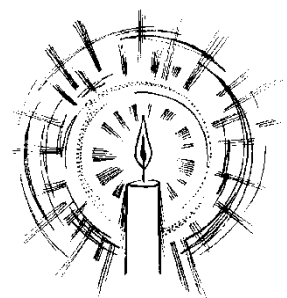

"In recent weeks many people will have made donations in response to the earthquake in Haiti and may feel that they have made their contribution for this year.
