The New Roman Missal for use at Masses in Ireland. A new edition of the Roman Missal will be used at Mass from the First Sunday of Advent, 27 November 2011. It will replace the book we have used since St Patrick's Day 1975. As a new edition it will contain the material added in the past thirty five years. This material includes

- three more Eucharistic Prayers, two for Reconciliation and a more recent one for Masses for Various Needs. Though these Prayers have been published separately, the new edition is the first opportunity to place them within the Missal. This also means that they will be used more frequently.
- Masses for over twenty feasts added since 1975. These feasts include St Pio of Pietrincina (Padre Pio), Maximillian Kolbe, Our Lady of Guadalupe and St Teresa Benedicta of the Cross (Edith Stein).
- the Masses for the saints on the National Calendar for Ireland.
- additional Mass texts in honour of the Blessed Virgin Mary and other additional prayers.

The new edition does not change the Mass. However, as well as being a new edition, it is a new translation. This is the part that will be most noticeable, though the changes in the people's prayers and responses are not many. The changes simply translate what is in the Latin and are guided by the Instruction on translation, *Liturgiam authenticam*, issued in 2001.

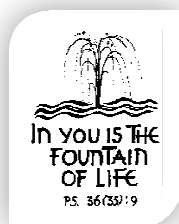

The Launch of New Counselling and Support Service for Survivors of Clerical and Religious abuse

"Towards Healing", the new Counselling and Support Service for Survivors of Clerical and Religious abuse has commenced providing services. The new "Towards Healing" service has been set-up following consultation between the Irish Catholic Bishops' Conference, CORI, the Irish Missionary Union and Faoiseamh, and with Survivor Groups, and is designed to ensure that Survivors of Clerical and Religious abuse receive Counselling and other support services in a more holistic manner than heretofore. The new service is a One-Church response to Clerical and Religious abuse and is being co-funded by the Irish Catholic Bishops' Conference, CORI and the Irish Missionary Union. The service will be provided by lay, independent Counsellors and Psychotherapists.
