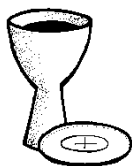

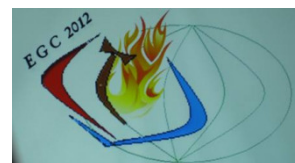


I will bring Holy Communion to the sick and the housebound on the First Friday this week. If a member of your family is housebound and not have the priest attending, please let me know.
