This is used to pay for the responsibilities of the Diocese in three main areas; 1. **The National Bishops' Conference.** 2. **"Towards Healing"**, the fund set up to provide counselling etc. for victims of child abuse in the country. 3. **The Dublin Marriage Tribunal.** The remainder is used for the running of the Diocese. The Budget Estimate for 2012 is €388,565 The Contribution from Kilbeggan Parish is €3,735.

The **second contribution** from the parish is for the 20% of the Christmas Offerings which comes to €2,394. This is used for the care of retired priests.

**Quotations are being sought from Contractors to demolish and remove the Old Teacher's Residence adjacent to Rahugh Parish Church for security reasons.**

The work involves ensuring all services are disconnected before demolishing the house, checking for any asbestos material which must be disposed off in accordance with Westmeath County Council Policy, demolishing the building including removal of foundations and dispose of all material in an appropriate manner off site. Any recoverable stone from the walls must be transported to the Local Community Centre. Care must be taken to protect the septic tank and well located on the site for the adjacent Church. The site must be levelled, top soiled and grass seeded to allow for future lawn mowing. A Quotations as a fixed price lump sum including VAT along with a copy of the Contractor's current Public & Employers Insurance Policy must be submitted to Fr. Brendan Corrigan no later than Friday 3rd February 2012. All interested Contractors should familiarise themselves with the house and site before quoting.
