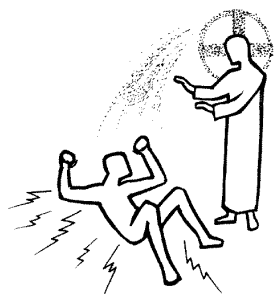

Meeting of the Parish Pastoral Council has passed the plans for the Parish Centre and the Parochial House. Planning Permission will now be sought from Westmeath Co. Co. Plans are on display in each church. Thanks to the Parish Council who have worked so hard to get the plans to this stage.

This is the notice we placed in the Bulletin on January 30th 2011. We are now at Stage 4 in the process and the plans are on display in the church.

Developing a Parish Centre

Following consultation with the Parish over the past few months the Parish Council have decided to commence the process of developing a Parish Centre. The initial stage will require engaging a Consultant Engineer \ Architectural Firm to Project Manage the process on behalf of the Parish Council. The process will involve developing the Parish Centre from concept to completion in stages. Approval by the Parish Council to commence each stage will be required.

Stage 1 I will advertise in the Local Press this coming week for Consultant Engineer \ Architectural Firm to Project Manage the development.

Stage 2 Appoint the Project Manager to develop the concept of a Parish Centre into preliminary outline drawings, site location map and initial cost estimate.

Stage 3 Following consultation with the Parish Council the Project Manager will prepare detailed plans, specifications and detailed cost estimate for the Parish Centre.

Stage 4 The Project Manager will apply for planning permission.

Stage 5 Following successful planning approval, the Project Manager will prepare contract documents, pricing bill and tender the Parish Centre.

Stage 6 Award of Contract to build the Parish Centre.

Stage 7 The Project Manager will supervise the construction and commissioning of the Parish Centre.

Stage 8 Hand over to the Parish.

At all stages of the development the Parish will be kept informed.
