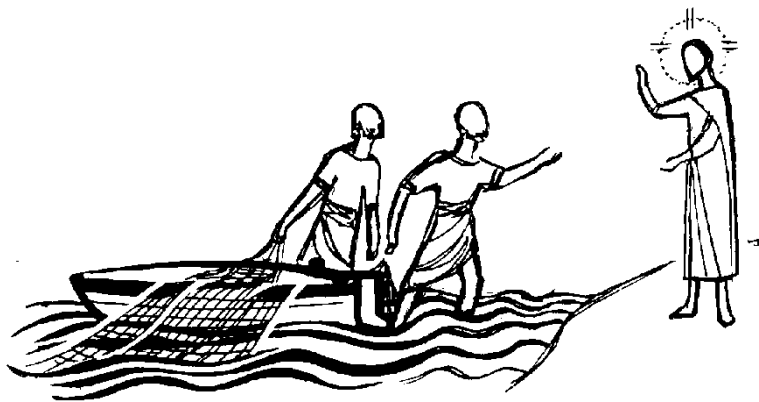

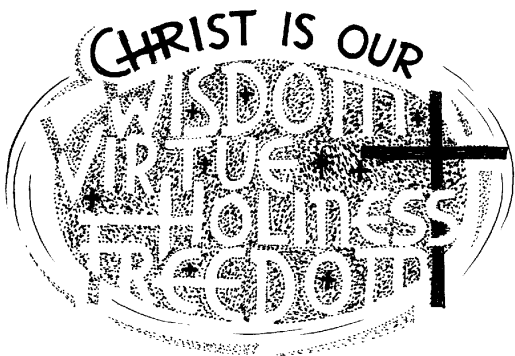

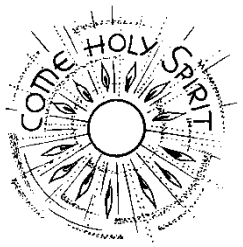

First Holy Communion in Rahugh at 9.30 a.m. on Sunday 22nd of May.





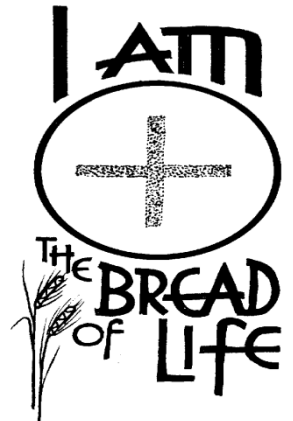

We will have Mass from the “**Do this in Memory of Me**” programme with the children for First Holy Communion Sunday at 11 a.m.



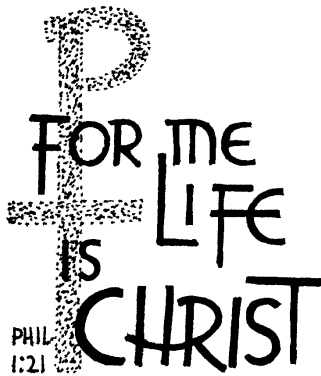
