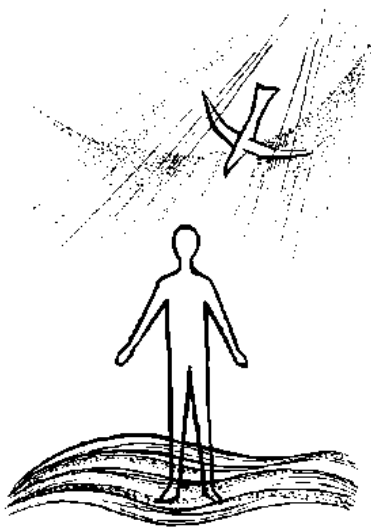

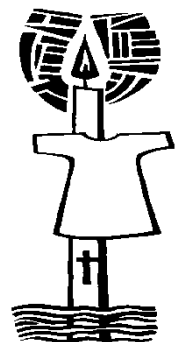

It was originally built for two priests and a live-in housekeeper, but now there is only one priest and no live-in house keeper.
