CEMETERY DEVOTIONS SUNDAY 25TH JULY AT 3 P.M.

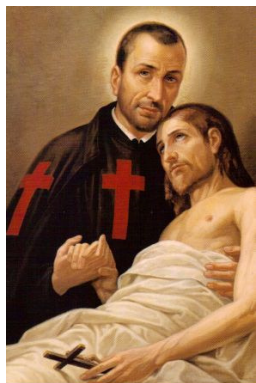
