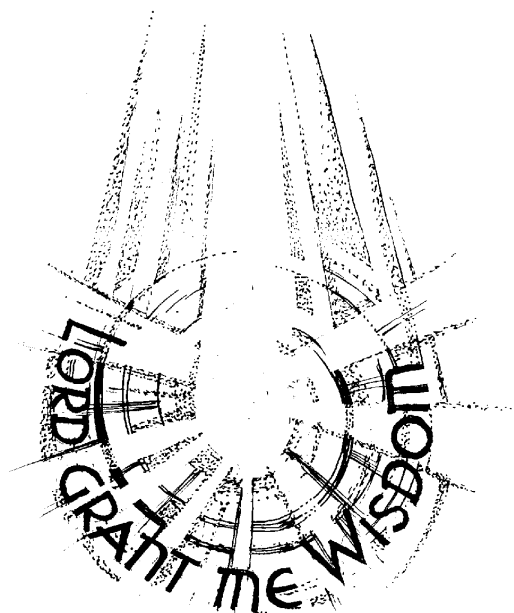

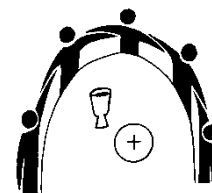

After discussion with the Parish Pastoral Council I had a meeting in the Chief Superintendents Office in Mullingar concerning collections at both churches in the parish. As you have seen the collectors are collecting right up to the door in Kilbeggan and each side of the gate in Rahugh. As a result people are under pressure to donate.

The law states that collectors must be 25 meters from the entrance to church grounds. This will now be enforced and in future the licence for Kilbeggan and Rahugh will only permit collections after Mass.
