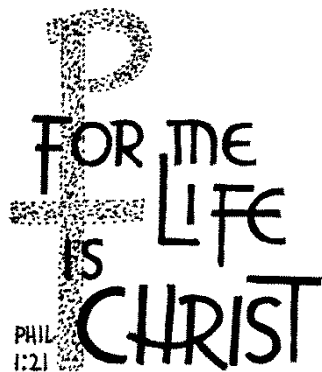

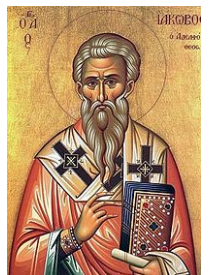

The sale has been agreed by The St. Finian's Diocesan Trust and the Bishop. The Parish Pastoral Council will now continue the process. The Parish Pastoral Council have decided that when the sale proceeds as expected the monies received will be used for the renovation and decoration of St. James' Church.
