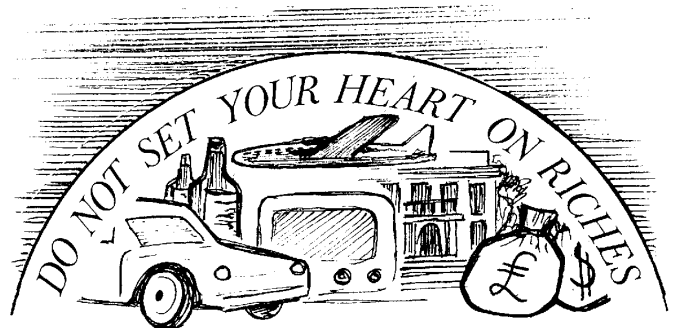

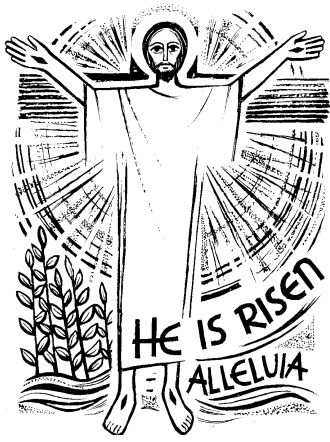

Booking Mass Intentions for 2011

There is a great tradition of families remembering deceased family members at an annual public Mass. People may begin booking Masses for 2011 now. Due to the high number of Masses being booked for weekends it is necessary for families to share. So if you book a Mass for a particular Saturday or Sunday and another family wants the same day, it will be necessary for both families to share the same Mass. This new arrangement will apply from January 2011.

Bishop Smith welcomed Sr Mary Hardiman home from Haiti. The Diocese of Meath raised over €305,000 following the earthquake in Haiti.

The proceeds of the collection have been made available to Sister Mary and her local community in Haiti, and also to Trocaire. Bishop Smith asked Sr Mary to speak at Masses in the Cathedral and Saint Paul's, Mullingar on Sunday 5 September outlining the nature of her work in Haiti and the use of funds from the appeal. Meanwhile, on the 6 month anniversary of the earthquake, Trocaire reports that parishes across Ireland helped to raise €4,681,168, which is now rebuilding shattered lives across Haiti. Thanks to your generosity, Trócaire has provided, Shelter to 900,000 people, Life-saving healthcare to one million people, Food to one and a half million people, Help rebuilding schools and hospitals, School-feeding programmes, Safe places for children in five main temporary camps, Trauma counselling and education for affected children. Trocaire is now planning a major five-year rebuilding and reconstruction programme. For more information visit www.trocaire.org.
