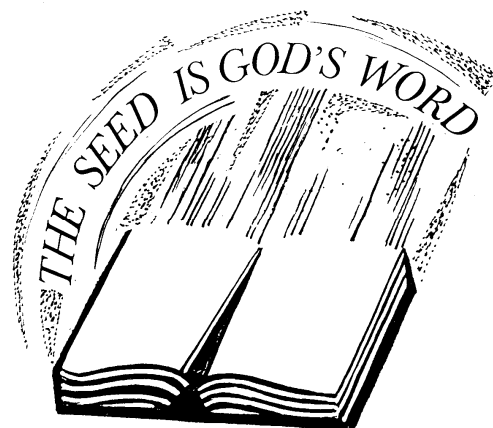

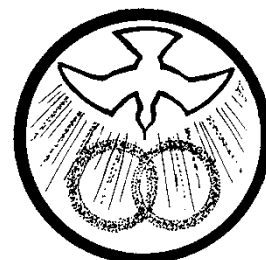
The Collection on Sunday is the annual Peters' Pence Collection for the apostolic work of the Holy Father.
