**Congratulations to all the Polish people who share life with us here in Kilbeggan.** This Sunday **Fr. Jerzy Popieluszko** who was

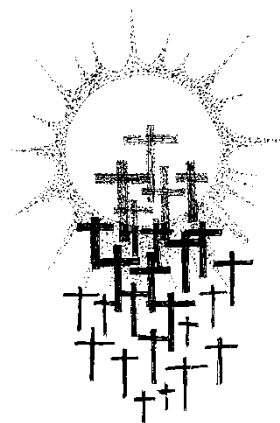
martyred in 1984 was beatified by Pope Benedict in Rome.
