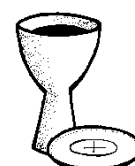

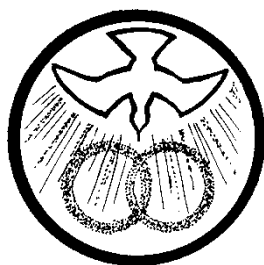
Mass celebrated by Fr. Shane in Rahugh Cemetery at 7.30 p.m. next Thursday 30th June.
