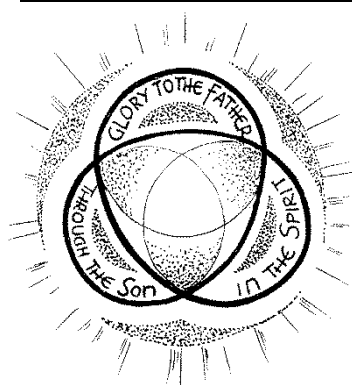

## **Mass to mark the 50<sup>th</sup> International Eucharistic Congress O Connor Park Tullamore followed by the annual Corpus Christi Procession to O Connor Square 9<sup>th</sup> June 2012**

On Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> June at 7.00pm, Tullamore Parish and the surrounding parishes are to mark the 50<sup>th</sup> International Eucharistic Congress with the celebration of Mass in O Connor Park followed by the annual Corpus Christi Procession led by Bishop Michael Smith through the streets of Tullamore, concluding with Benediction in O Connor Square. Gates will be open in O Connor Park from 6.15pm and **people are asked to be seated by 7.00pm.** Those wishing to attend this historic celebration are asked to use the car parks throughout the town rather than parking around O Connor Park, bearing in mind that the celebrations will conclude in O Connor Square. The following are some of the car parks available: Market Square, Texas Car Park (pay), Spollens car park, Hand Ball Alley, Bridge Centre Car Park, Tanyard, The Quarry car park (beside Offaly Historical Society) the Health Centre (both sides of the Road), Parish car park, church grounds and all streets away from O Connor Park and town Centre. Parking will only be available for those who are disabled at the GAA centre, please use entrance nearest the Kilbeggan Bridge.

It is an international gathering of people, which aims to promote an awareness of the central place of the Eucharist in the life and mission of the Catholic Church; help improve our understanding and celebration of the liturgy and draw attention to the social dimension of the Eucharist.
