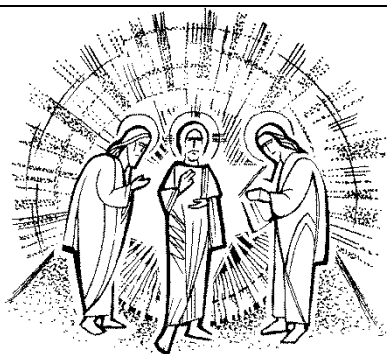

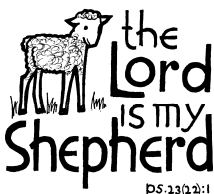

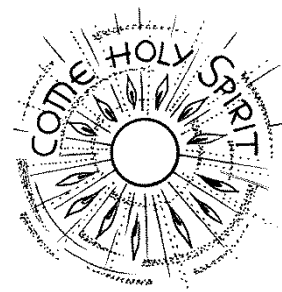


**I hope to have the Commissioning of the new Ministers of the Eucharist and

**Last Call to Volunteer for the 50<sup>th</sup> International Eucharistic Congress**

The [50th International Eucharistic Congress 2012](http://www.iec2012.ie) will take place in Dublin from 10<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> June 2012. This will be the biggest international event in Ireland in 2012 and one that will have a significant impact for Ireland and for the Irish Catholic Church. Volunteers will have an integral role to play in the success of the Congress. Volunteers are now being recruited for a wide range of roles and if you would like to get involved please visit the Congress website [www.iec2012.ie/volunteer](http://www.iec2012.ie/volunteer) and fill out an online application or request an application form from the Congress office on (01) 2349919 or [volunteeradmin@iec2012.ie](mailto:volunteeradmin@iec2012.ie). Please note that the closing date for volunteer applications is **Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> March 2012.**

The Congress will be held in Dublin from June 10 to June 17 in Dublin. The first 6 days of the Congress will be stationed in RDS, Ballsbridge, and will consist of Special Masses and other Liturgies, Workshops, and Talks on aspects of the Eucharist. Anyone who would like to participate in this part of the Congress must register. You may attend for all or any part of the Congress, e.g. for one day, for three days or for every event during the week. If you register to attend any part of the week in RDS, you will be entitled to receive a ticket for the Final Mass—“Statio Orbis”—in Croke Park on June 17<sup>th</sup>. Details of booking and charges can be accessed on the Congress Website [:www.iec2012.ie/registration](http://www.iec2012.ie/registration). If you do not use Internet, you may call the Registration Office at 01-2981122. Bookings will not be accepted after 9 May 2012. Bookings can be made on an individual basis, or for groups or for families. For those who wish to attend the “Statio Orbis” (Final Mass) only, a limited number of tickets—are available in the Parish. The tickets will be allocated by lottery.
