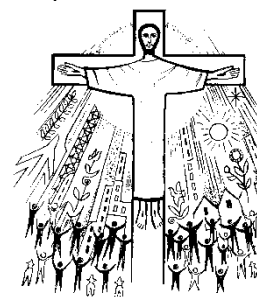


Mass of Anointing of the Sick and Elderly.
