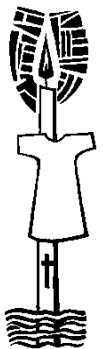

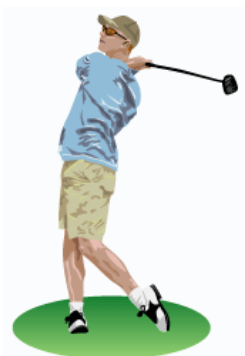
The revised child protection policy and procedures for the Diocese of Meath have been published, following consultation with the HSE and the National Board for Safeguarding Children. It describes what is expected at parish level to ensure that children are kept safe while taking part in Church activities and how volunteers can be supported. It also outlines the diocesan structures for responding to concerns and complaints. The document is being distributed to parishes at the moment and it is available on the new diocesan child protection website www.meathsafeguarding.ie, which will go live on Friday 21 May.

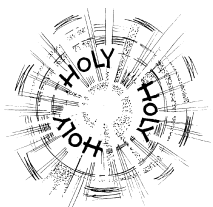
