Visit a typical Catholic Parish in Ireland, and one will find that on average over two thirds of the congregation are women. Why are there so few men actively participating in the life of the church? In a major recession, with rising unemployment ([300,000 men on live register](#)), the growth of debt, and [suicide four times more common among Irish men](#), does the Gospel offer men hope, in the midst of challenging times?
