**Annual Regional Pioneer Mass** will be held in Rathwire Church on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> November at 3 p.m.



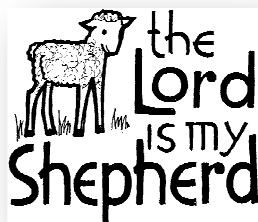
