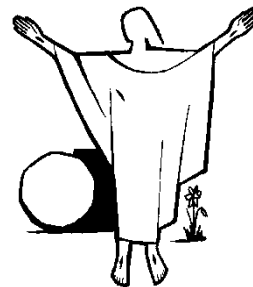

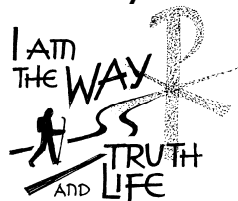

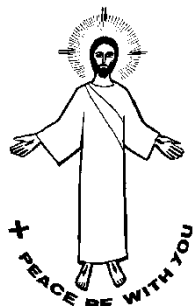

List of the Dead

List of the Dead and Memorial Cards will be placed before the altar at Masses in November.

Bishop Matthew Gaffney will be re-buried in the Cathedral grounds following the 10 am Mass in the Cathedral on Monday next, November 2. Consultations with his surviving relatives some years ago indicated that they were most anxious that he be buried in the Cathedral grounds. This year is the 100th anniversary of his death (he died on December 15, 1909) and in a few weeks time a book on the Cathedral is being launched. This book commemorates the 70th anniversary of the decision by Bishop Mulvany to begin the project and the 60th anniversary of its Dedication in 1939. In his first Pastoral letter as Bishop in 1900, Bishop Gaffney announced his intention to begin preparation for the building, in Mullingar, of a Cathedral for the Diocese. Some weeks following the publication of the Pastoral, the Committee set up to oversee the project held its first meeting at which a sum of £15,000 was pledged - 8% of the final contract price. Bishop Gaffney was buried in the Franciscan Church in Multyfarnham.
