It can be a time for families to get together and celebrate their unity and the love in their families. Some families like to read at anniversary Masses. Following a meeting with the Readers and Ministers of the Eucharist it was decided;



1. If you would like to read at your family Mass please contact the reader who is assigned to that particular Sunday and let them know your intention to read a week in advance. If not the scheduled reader will read as normal.
2. During the year there will be Masses for various groups, like the Communion or Confirmation children or for various groups within the parish. So if you have booked a Mass and one of these group Masses is already or subsequently organised the Mass will cover both intentions. Or, if a funeral has to be organised for the same time as a Mass you have booked, the Mass will cover both intentions.
