## **Mission Sunday Collection**

The Collections at Masses this weekend are for Missionaries abroad. Last year, the people of Meath Diocese contributed a total of € 177,623 to the Mission Sunday appeal, making it the second largest diocesan contribution in Ireland. There are 1,976 Irish missionaries currently serving throughout the world. Funds raised from the collection last year were allocated to missionaries and associated projects in 13

countries, including India, South Africa, Liberia and Botswana. Projects supported by the funds raised through the Mission Sunday collection included the building of simple mission churches, the education of seminarians and the formation of lay leaders. The Mission Sunday gift was also used for the building of health clinics for children, emergency aid in times of war or natural disaster and assisted missionaries in their efforts to care for refugees.

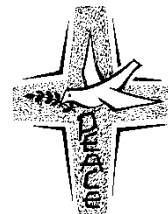

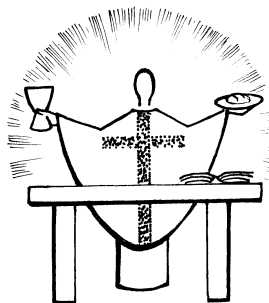
## **List of the Dead**

1. If you would like to read at your family Mass please contact the reader who is assigned to that particular Sunday and let them know your intention to read a week in advance. If not the scheduled reader will read as normal.
2. During the year there will be Masses for various groups, like the Communion or Confirmation children or for various groups within the parish. So if you have booked a Mass and one of these group Masses is already or subsequently organised the Mass will cover both intentions. Or, if a funeral has to be organised for the same time as a Mass you have booked, the Mass will cover both intentions.
