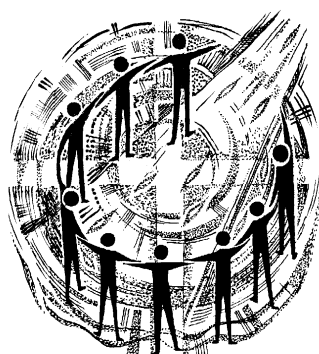

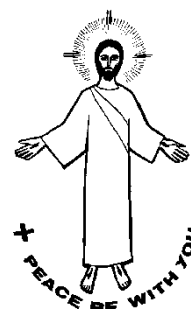
NOVEMBER INDULGENCES
