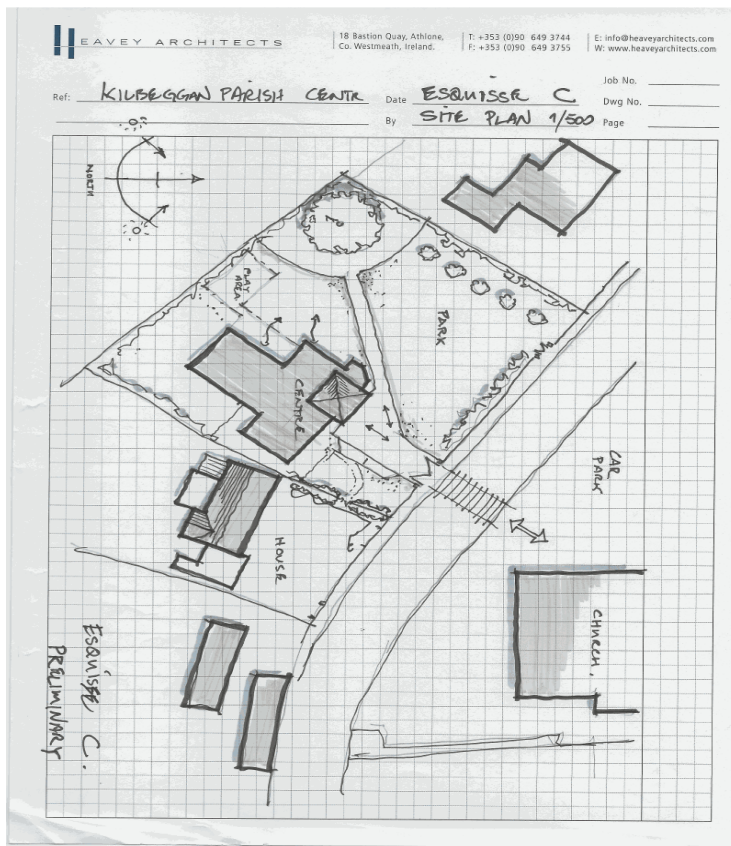

Parish Centre and Parochial House

At a meeting of the Parish Pastoral Council on Monday night it was decided to proceed with the plans to renovate the Parochial House for Fr. Brendan, and to build a Parish Centre.

All the ideas you have submitted to the Council have been given serious thought and we would like to thank you for your ideas and interest. We believe that all views were reflected in our decision. It is hoped that the final plans for the house and centre can now go ahead.

The centre will provide a comfortable place for parish and community groups to meet and work for the good of the community. The active retirement group will make it their base, use it for their events and be able to invite other similar groups to join them.



It is also hoped that families will be able to use it for refreshments after funerals. It will be very suitable for mother and toddler groups and for the young people of the parish. It will be used for Parish meetings, for Communion and Confirmation meetings and for various courses in the Faith, prayer meetings etc. The sheds beside the Parochial House are listed buildings and we are not able to incorporate them into the plan. There would also be a park area at the Centre and a possible play area.

Our dream is that the centre will help to build parish and community spirit. If you believe the centre could be put to other uses please let the council know. These are two major projects for our parish. Thank you for all your goodwill and support.
