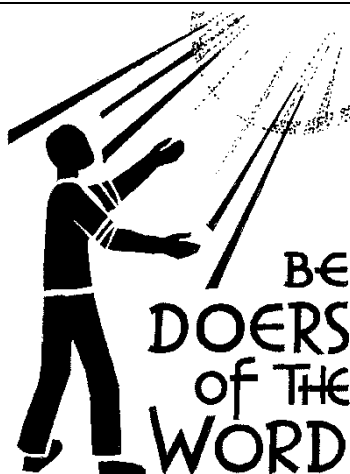

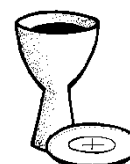

receive Holy Communion, please let me know.



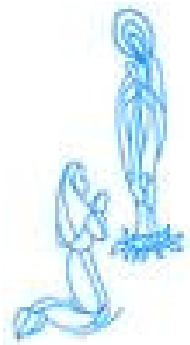

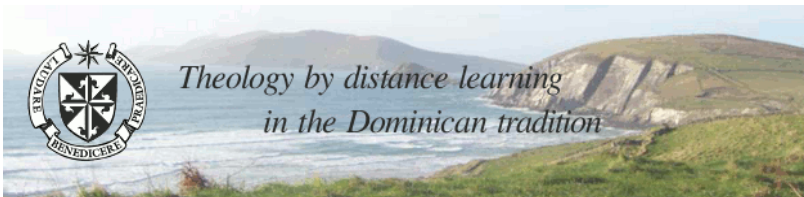
