“There are currently 119 priests in this Diocese. Of these, 19 are on loan from foreign dioceses or from religious congregations. Of the remaining 100 incardinated priests of the diocese, 37 are over seventy and there are 21 of these men still serving in parishes who are over the age of 70 years. The Diocese then has 63 priests of its own who are under 70 while there are 69 parishes in the Diocese. Clearly, the shortage of priests will hit further very soon. Indeed, I am currently having discussions with priests about appointments for this year and it is becoming more difficult to fill all positions within the Diocese.” Bishop Deenihan
