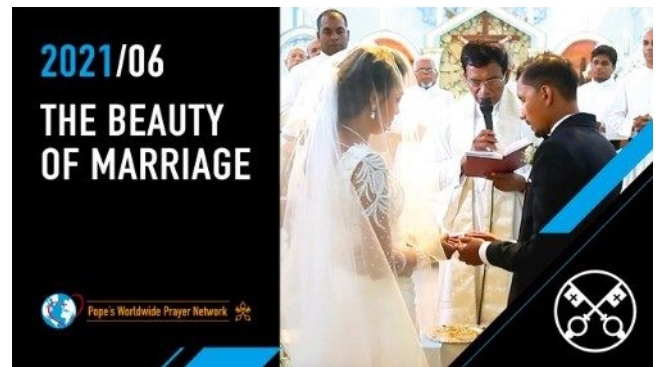

Relic Cemetery Committee

As you may be aware we are a voluntary committee that maintains the grounds of the Cemetery, both the old graveyard & the present graveyard. We also maintain graves that may be neglected or have no living relatives to maintain the graves.

Our main sources of income are from the collection at the Cemetery on Cemetery Sunday. However last year due to the pandemic Cemetery Sunday was cancelled & without the very generous donation from KPDA the Committee would have been forced to disband.

This year it is again unlikely that Cemetery Sunday will be held & again the finances of the Committee will be seriously affected. Unless we can organize a fundraiser immediately to help our serious financial position the Committee will be forced to disband.

With very limited means of raising finance the Committee are opening a GoFundMe page to ask the people of Kilbeggan both home & away to donate whatever they can to keep the Committee going.

People can also donate by envelope marked for the Cemetery Committee & leave the envelope in the collection box in the Church.
