**Tom Deenihan, on Saturday 14th August in St Mary's**

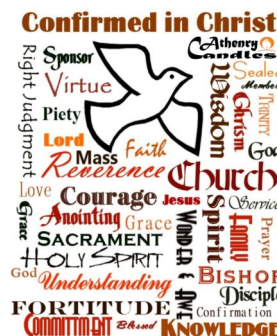
