**Pope Francis appoints three women to the Vatican's Dicastery for Bishops:** Sr. Raffaella Petrini, F.S.E., Secretary General of the Governorate of the Vatican City State; Sr. Yvonne Reungoat, F.M.A, former Superior General of the Daughters of Mary Help of Christians; and, Dr. Maria Lia Zerino, President of the World Union of Catholic Women's Organizations.
