Meath Diocesan Pilgrimage to Knock on 14th August 2022



The Meath Diocesan pilgrimage to Knock will be renewed this year and will take place at the start of the Knock Novena on Sunday 14th August. The Pilgrimage will be led by Bishop Thomas Deenihan. The Anointing of the Sick takes place in the Basilica at 2.30pm and Mass is at 3.00pm. The Rosary procession will follow outside on the grounds of the Shrine, weather permitting. Pray for suffering Christians in Nigeria.

At least 68 Christians have been killed, with many more abducted or displaced in the last couple of months in Central Nigeria's Benue State. Aid to the Church in Need, a Pontifical Charity that supports the faithful wherever they are oppressed, persecuted, or in need, received a report from Bishop Wilfred Chikpa Anagbe of Makurdi, Benue, highlighting the concerning scale of the situation and pointing at the inaction on the part of Nigerian authorities. He said that "the scale of killings, displacement, and wanton destruction of property by these Fulani jihadist militias only buttresses the now revealed agenda to depopulate Christian communities in Nigeria and take over lands.
