Let us take an interest in what is happening, let us help those who suffer and let us pray, because prayer is the gentle strength that protects and sustains the world.

13 Million Children in need of Water and Food In a statement, the United Nations agency said that access to humanitarian aid and lifesaving services is currently constrained, leaving over 13 million children in need of humanitarian assistance including water and nutrition. Further, an estimated 5.6 million children in the five Darfur states face “grave risks”, with 270,000 of them newly displaced by fighting so far, UNICEF said. More than one million children have been displaced by two months of conflict while over 5 million faces “grave risk” as situations deteriorate in Sudan, UNICEF says.
