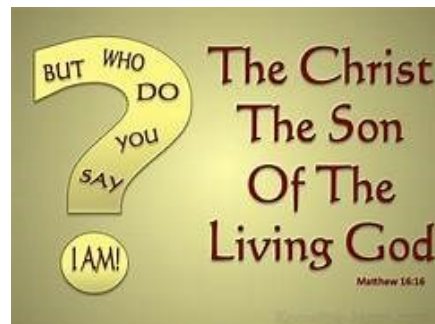

The Parish Pastoral Assembly will have its next meeting on Tuesday, August 29th at 7.30 p.m. in the Parish Centre.

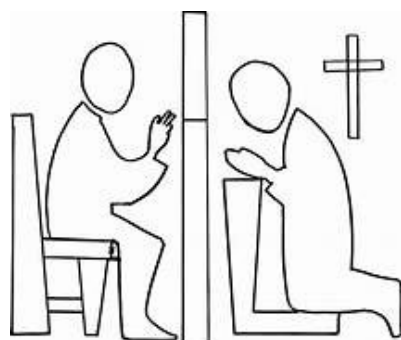

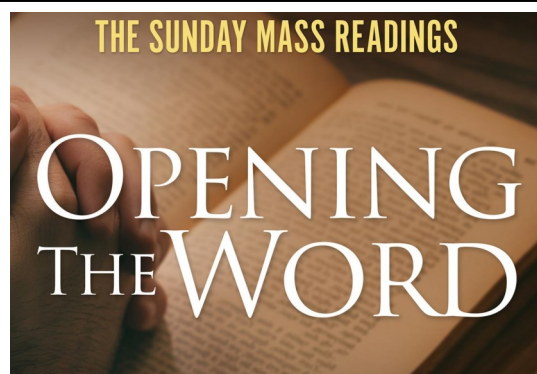
#### What will happen at the meetings:
