These are the basic requirements for Confirmation.

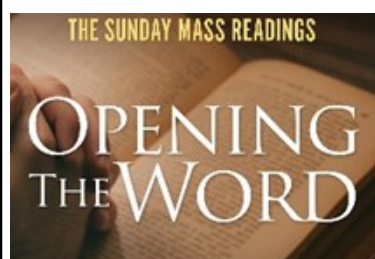


Parish Charity Shop
