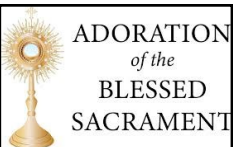

"They destroyed the walls of the church, but not the faith. Our faith remains strong; the people of God in Falam continue to believe and hope. The faithful will rebuild the Church of Christ the King; everyone will do their part," said Bishop Lucius Hre Kung of Hakha, during a pastoral visit to the ruins of the Church of Christ the King in Falam, Chin State. The Church was opened in 2023.
