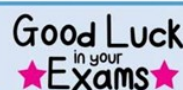

**Magnifica Humanitas, (Magnificent Humanity) - On Safeguarding the Human Person in the Time of Artificial Intelligence.**

Pope Leo XIV signed the document on May 15, marking the 135th anniversary of the promulgation of **Rerum novarum** by **Pope Leo XIII**.
